

Tuesday, October 22nd we sold 2,726 head of cattle of all classes. Slaughter cows were 3.00 to 5.00 higher. Heiferette types sold 5.00 to 7.00 higher. Light tests on bulls. Our afternoon Stocker Feeder Special featured mostly ranch raised bawling calves weighing 400 to 600 lbs and receiving 2 rounds of vaccinations. Steers and heifers under 600 lbs sold unevenly steady. Heifer calves sold 2.00 to 5.00 higher with yearling heifers trending 5.00 to 6.00 higher. Demand was mostly good throughout the sale, bidding active in the seats and online.
